Bring and Buy Guide & Rules

When printing the form make sure all of it is printed, some printers may not print close to the edge so use "Print to Fit".

ID Numbers can be obtained at the Bring & Buy table or before the convention by emailing BringandBuy@ayacon.org.uk.

Every item you bring should have it's own unique item number from **1 to a maximum of 60**.

Mark each item clearly with your Bring & Buy ID number, eg "ID: 22", unique item number and item price.

Please enter one item per line giving the matching unique sequential number and price you marked item with.

Use separate sheets for "**Manga & Books**", "**DVD and Media**" & "**Everything Else**" and continue the sequential item numbers from sheet to sheet to a **Maximum of 60 items** spanning as many sheets as required.

Manga & Books: Manga, Books, Artbooks. If you have a Artbook with DVD, if the Artbook is the main selling point it can go here, it's up to you.

DVD and Media: DVDs, Blu-ray, CDs, Laserdisc, other optical/digital media formats.

Everything Else: If you don't think it goes in the other 2 sections, put it here.

Labels should look something like this:

So not to get confused with item numbers.

If an item loses it's label we may not be able to sell it. Post-It notes are not recommended. Make sure labels on clothing are secure as they have a tendency to fall off.

Please make sure labels are correct and clear to read, if not we may not be able to sell your item.

If the price on the form and label do not match we will go by the price on the form you signed.

We do not take **VHS Tapes** (unless it's part of another item or very, very rare, most will be rejected).

We do not take **fake/pirate** goods, any spotted will be put to one side and not sold.

Please be aware we will not be responsible for loss or damage to the items, so please make sure loose and delicate items are packed within reason so they won't be damaged while on display. We may refuse to take badly packed items.

Aya Revolution Ltd will deduct a 10% commission on all items sold.
Money and unsold goods to be collected between
13:00 & 16:00 on Sunday 21st August 2011.

Please read the following declaration, and sign each sheet before handing it and your bring and buy items over.

I guarantee that all items listed below are my property. I authorise Aya Revolution Ltd to sell them at the prices listed below & agree that Aya Revolution Ltd will deduct **10% commission**. I acknowledge that Aya Revolution Ltd is not responsible for any loss or damage to items placed on the Bring and Buy. I understand that all unsold goods and money must be collected by **16:00 on Sunday 21st August 2011**. I understand that any uncollected goods and money after this time will be held for 1 month and then disposed of to the benefit of the convention charity. Uncollected goods will be forwarded on request after postage has been either paid, or deducted from any money held by Aya Revolution Ltd.
